



Adults Supporting Learning (ASLs) in “Out of School Hours’ Sport”

Target: Adults Supporting Learning who are coaching sport in schools as an Out of School Hours’ Sport.

Course Content: At the end of the course, candidates will be able to:

- describe what constitutes an appropriate high quality learning experience for pupils/students through “Out of School Hours’ Sport”.
- recognise what is required of (i) the school and its management of ASLs and (ii) an ASL working outside the PE curriculum
- understand some of the key entitlement issues - inclusion and differentiated learning, progression and gender etc.
- understand issues of communication particularly with younger pupils
- understand the ‘duty of care’ role of the ASL
- understand the concept of risk assessing activities and increase knowledge of safe practice in Out of School hours’ Sport
